



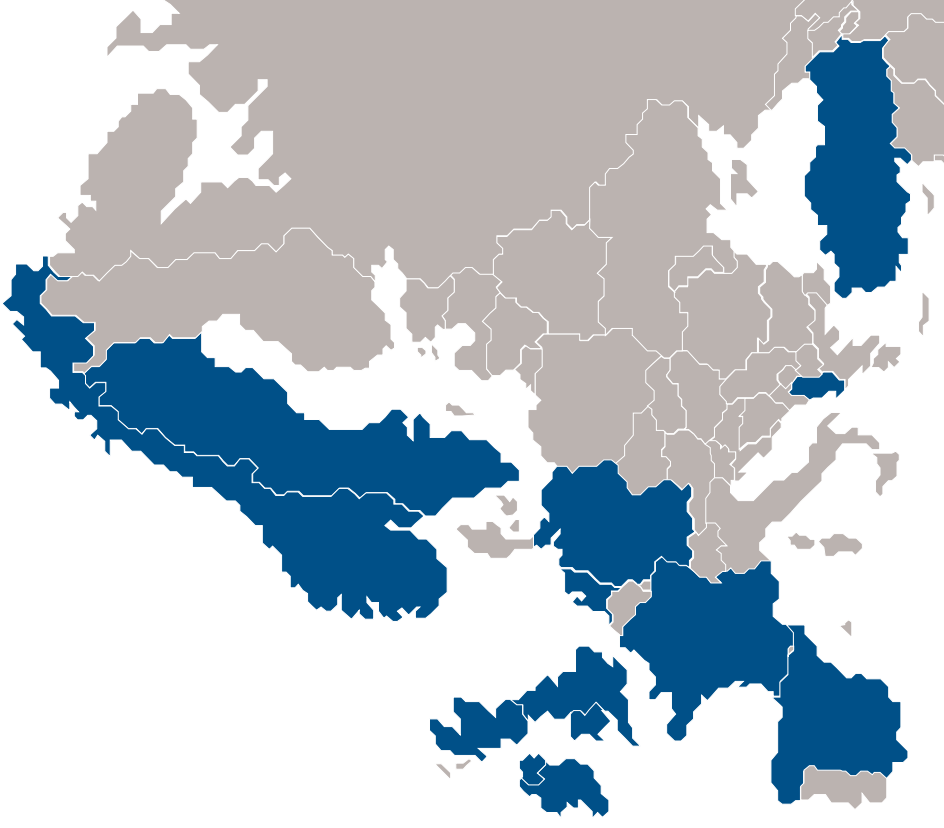

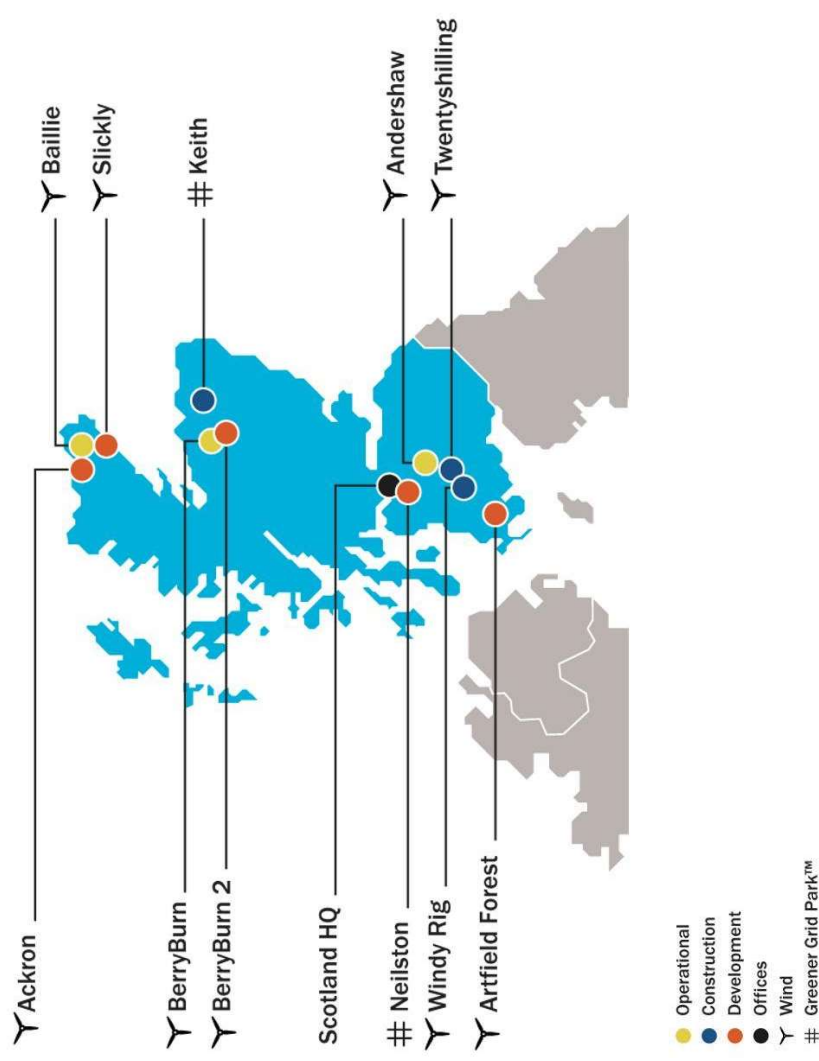
About Statkraft

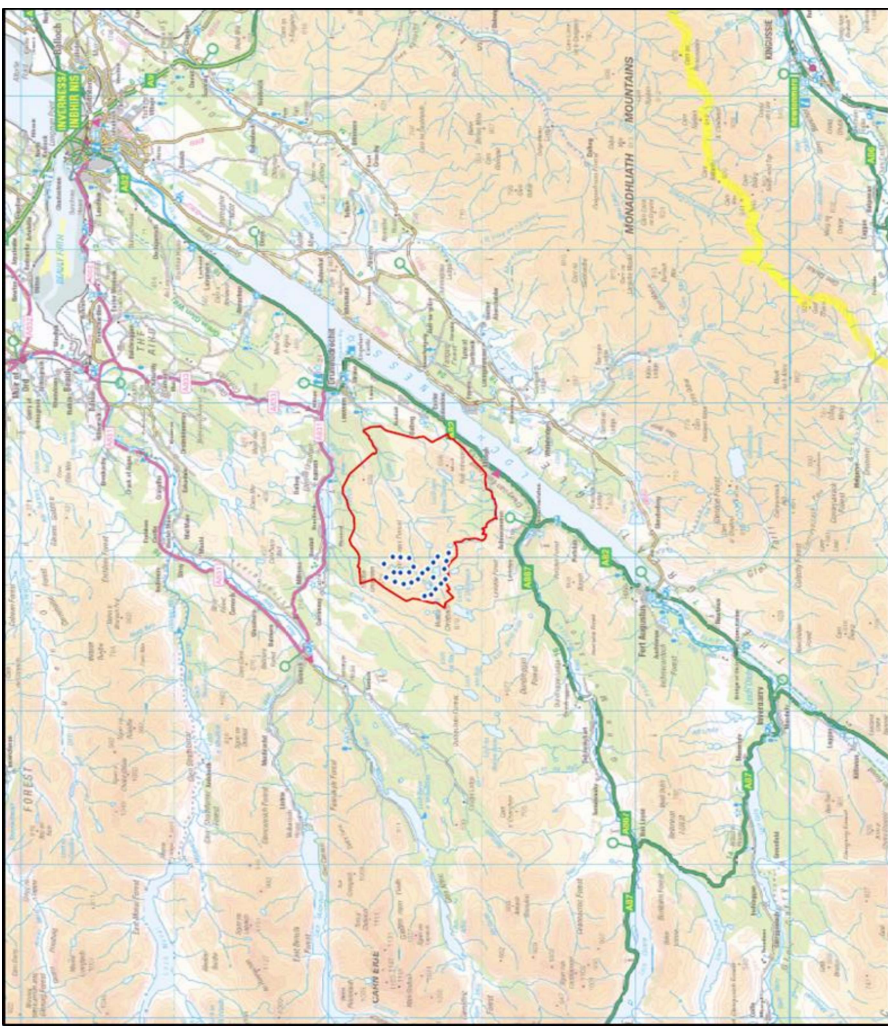

Site Location and Potential

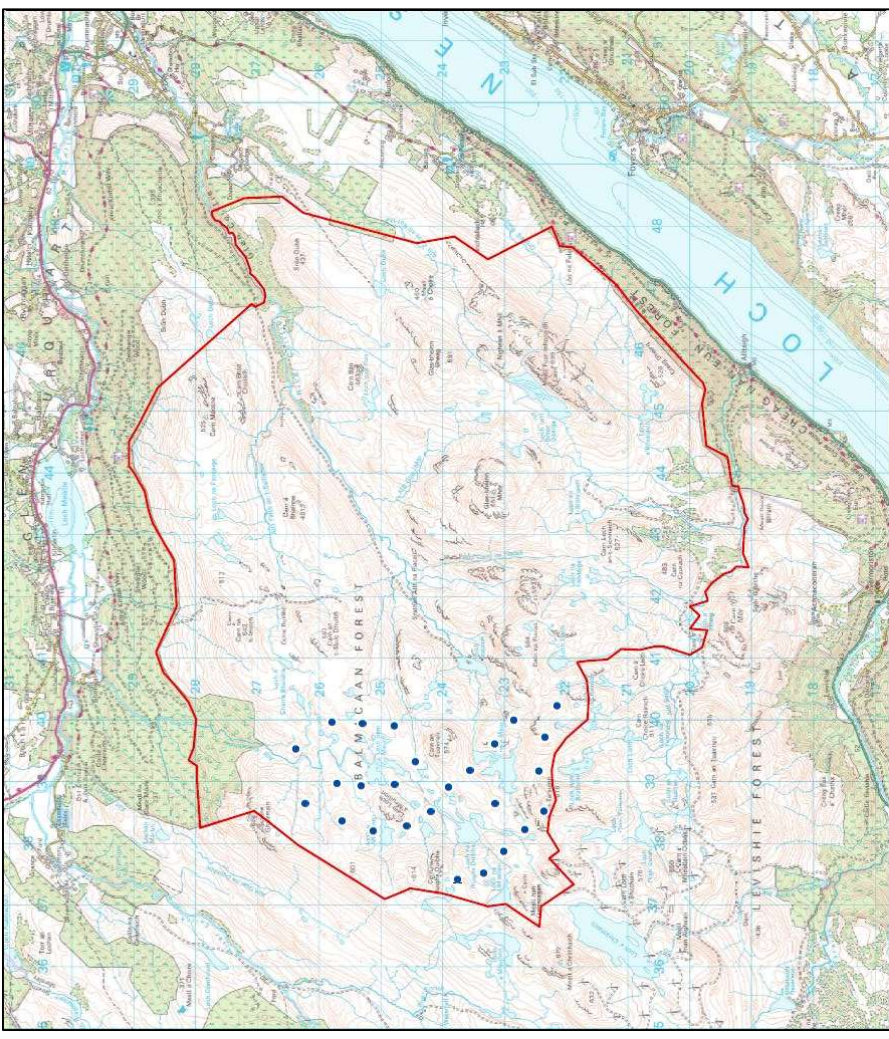
- The proposed turbines are located approximately 10km southwest of Drumnadrochit
- A maximum of 26 wind turbines
- Considering up to 200 metres tip height
- Project size to be determined as studies are undertaken and consultation feedback received



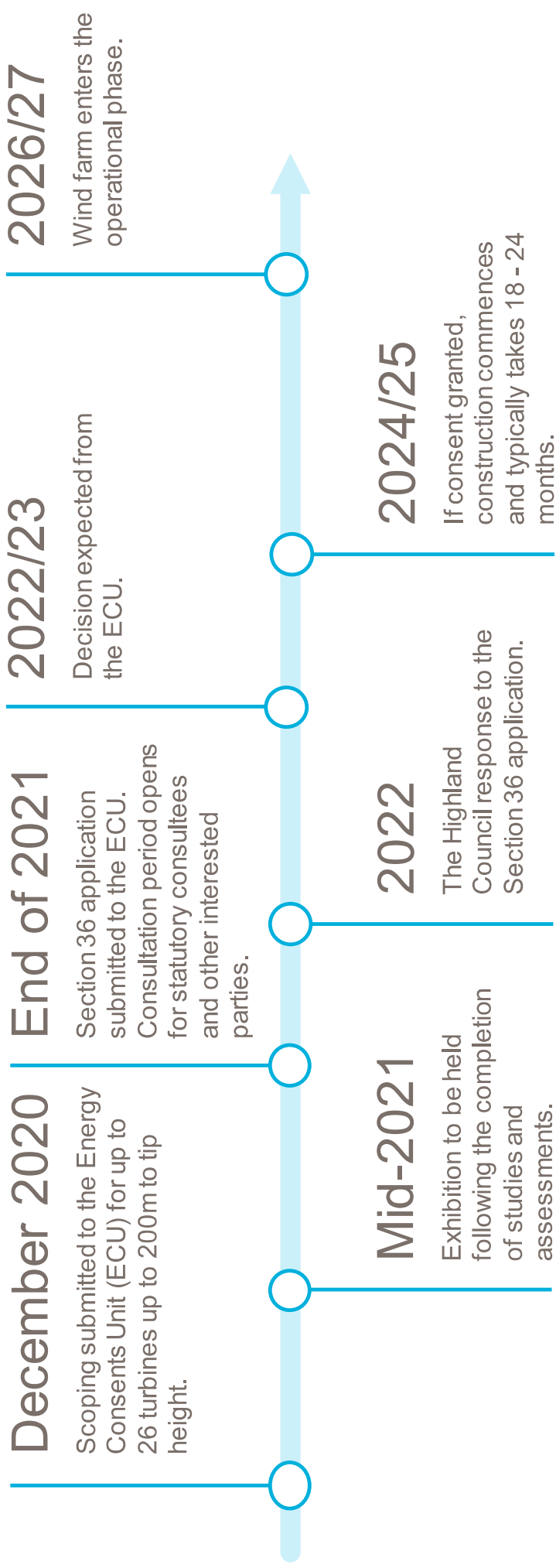
About the Site

Site History

- The site does not currently have any turbines.
- The proposed Loch Liath scheme will be designed to sit alongside the operational Bhlaraidh Wind Farm.
- SSE Renewables have proposed an Extension to Bhlaraidh Wind Farm. The extension was Scoped in July 2019.
